

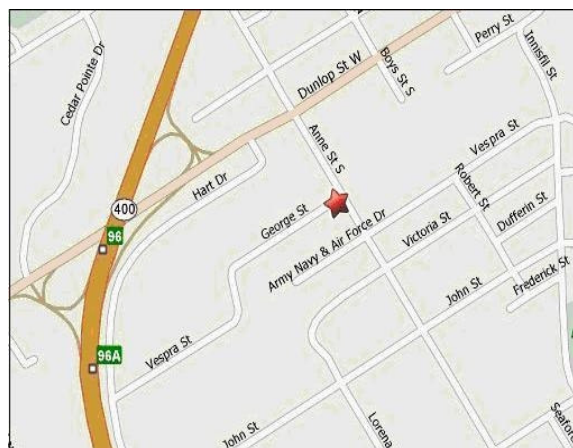
J. B. Orange, PhD

Dr. Orange graduated from Queen's University at Kingston, Ontario with a Bachelor of Science degree in Life Sciences. He completed his graduate work in speech-language pathology at the University of Toronto and his doctoral education at the State University of New York at Buffalo. Dr. Orange completed a post-doctoral research fellowship from the R. Samuel McLaughlin Centre for Gerontological Health Research at McMaster University in Hamilton, Ontario. During his research fellowship, Dr. Orange completed several studies on the language and communication of individuals with Alzheimer's disease and their caregivers.

Dr. Orange's peer-reviewed publications and funded research address language and cognitive-communication disorders of adults and older adults. Current research projects include the analyses of language, discourse and conversation of individuals with Alzheimer's disease, aphasia, frontotemporal lobe dementia, and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis. Other on-going studies include communication enhancement education and training programs for family caregivers of individuals with dementia.
